Dear Parents/ Guardians,


Please find enclosed herewith the CBSE Circular No. CE/COORD/SPS/2020 dated 24.01.2020 regarding the initiatives taken by CBSE to ensure that students should not face any problem in appearing in the examinations. You are aware that the Board-Examinations for your ward of Class X would commence from February 26, 2020 and continue till March 18, 2020.

You are, therefore, requested to attend a Briefing Session on Monday, February 3, 2020 at 9.00 a.m. in the school conference room and also go through the circular and follow the instructions strictly.

Kindly note down the following instructions also:

1. The Admit Cards will be given to your ward on February 4, 2020 during the school hours.
2. The Admit Card will be issued to your ward only after the 'No Dues Form' clearance. Kindly ask your ward to get the 'No Dues Form' cleared from the different departments of the school.
3. Kindly make sure that the Admit Card is signed by your ward and also by Father/Mother of the candidate at appropriate place provided. Please be informed that without the necessary signatures, the candidates will not be allowed to appear for the exams at the Examination Centre.

**Sub:- Briefing session to guide students appearing in Boards
Examinations - Reg.**

Dear Madam/Sir,

You are aware that Board's Examinations for Classes X & XII would commence from 15th February, 2020 and continue till 30th March, 2020.

Your school will be sponsoring students for Classes X & XII. You are also aware that holding examinations successfully is the responsibility of all the stakeholders to protect the future of the students and also to have faith of citizens in our system.

CBSE has taken many initiatives to ensure that students should not face any problem in appearing in the examinations. Also many steps have been taken to conduct the examinations successfully. Another step proposed in this direction is to hold a briefing session of the students appearing on the Board's Examinations when they are called to collect their admit card by their school.

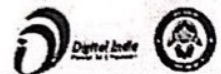
You are, therefore, requested to hold a briefing session for both students and parents and following information may be communicated to them for strict compliance:-

1. That last entry in the examination centre is 10:00 AM. For Whatever reason, no candidate will be allowed after 10:00AM in the examination centre. No re-examination will be conducted for such students who have not reported on time.
2. Candidates will visit their examination centre prior to the examinations to confirm the location, distance, traffic condition etc. They should leave their home much in advance so that they reach examination centre as per schedule and on time.
3. No candidate will be allowed to leave the examination centre before the examination is over.
4. They will carry only Blue / Royal blue ball point/Gel /Fountain pen, pencil, eraser, sharpener, Geometry instruments, colors, brushes, Admit Card and School Identity Card as per requirement in a transparent pouch.
5. They will not carry mobile, other electronic items and the barred items (list is available on Board's website).
6. Students will go only in school uniform for appearing in the examination.
7. They will follow all the instructions given to them by the Assistant Superintendents (Invigilators).


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8. They will complete entries on answer book and on question paper correctly and neatly.
9. They will write their Roll Number correctly. For the same, a power point presentation is also being sent to you. Kindly understand this presentation and explain to the students.
10. They will not indulge in any unfair practices. If found, they will be booked under unfair means activities and action will be taken accordingly.
11. They should not believe in fake videos and messages uploaded on social media regarding leakage of question paper or forward them. They should not give ear to rumors and they should not spread rumors too. CBSE will make efforts to identify such videos and messages on social media platform, lodge an FIR against involved people and provide the information of such links on Board's website.
12. They may be requested by Assistant Superintendent(Invigilator) to witness opening of question paper and their signature on certificate printed on the envelope of question paper. While doing so, they will check that packet is properly sealed and intact.
13. In case, there is any ambiguity found in question paper, they will bring it to the notice of their school for informing the same to the CBSE to address the same as per Board's policy rather than going to social media.
14. They will maintain discipline in the examination centre, protect the furniture etc. and will not litter and ensure cleanliness.
15. Inform them to ensure that personal data given in Admit Card is correct and for the same both parent and candidates will sign undertaking given in Admit Card.
16. In addition to above, school may also give other important instructions.

I am sure that with your efforts, we will successfully conduct the examination.
